The Tłıchǫ negotiated a comprehensive land claims and self-government ("Tłıchǫ Agreement") in which the Tłıchǫ have complete ownership of 39,000 square kilometres of land (surface and sub-surface), self-government powers and management of resources. The principles and objectives of the Tłıchǫ Agreement are to protect, promote and enhance the Tłıchǫ language, culture and way of life. The Tłıchǫ Agreement became effective on August 4, 2005. This is an exciting time for the Tłıchǫ and the Tłıchǫ Government as we move forward with self-determination.
