Rabesca's have provided other services and programs to the region and beyond including management consulting and cultural integration workshops. Sah Naji Kwe Lodge Sah Naji Kwe Lodge, formerly known as Sah Naji Kwe Camp and/or Sah Naji Kwe Wilderness Spa and Meeting Place, was established in 1987 on the shores of Great Slave near Frank Channel. Originally setup as a tent frame cabin camp with a general outfitting and tourist establishment license camp services provided fishing services and cultural demonstration products. Currently, along with the original tent frame cabin lodge, Sah Naji Kwe provides year round accommodations, meeting facilities and meals for small groups in a comfortable and beautiful setting.



This area provides an abundant source of fine marine glacial clay which gave the unique opportunity for therapeutic use hence the wilderness spa concept.

Rabesca's have also developed a line of skin care products utilizing the clay yet to be brought to the market place.

Camp Ekwo Camp Ekwo was established in 1990 as a big game outfitting operation for central barrenground caribou. The operation consists of two separate camps, one located on Humpy Lake and the other on Little Forehead Lake. Humpy Lake has been known for setting world records for central barrenground caribou since 1994 and still holding. In recent years, with caribou population and migration changes, Rabesca's have begun to diversify into new areas of non-consumptive activities utilizing the barrenground camps including field television workshops.
