The Tłichǫ negotiated a comprehensive land claims and self-government ("Tłichǫ Agreement") in which the Tłichǫ have complete ownership of 39,000 square kilometres of land (surface and sub-surface), self-government powers and management of resources. The principles and objectives of the Tłichǫ Agreement are to protect, promote and enhance the Tłichǫ language, culture and way of life. The Tłichǫ Agreement became effective on August 4, 2005. This is an exciting time for the Tłichǫ and the Tłichǫ Government as we move forward with self-determination.

The Tłichǫ Lands Protection Director is accountable for directing and managing the Tłichǫ Lands Protection Department. This includes directing and supervising staff within the department and managing financial and budgeting responsibilities. The Director is responsible for managing the development, implementation and updating of the Tłichǫ land use plan and ensuring the assessment of technical submission for land and water use, including for mining and industrial development. The Director is accountable for overseeing development and operations of land use administration for Tłichǫ land and ensuring all procedures comply with relevant federal laws and Tłichǫ legislation.
