- b. All trips will be 14 days in length. This will allow groups to travel at a safe pace and make stops at significant sites along the way.
- c. There will be no alcohol or drugs allowed on the journey. Use of drugs and alcohol in this program is both unsafe and disrespectful. Anyone bringing or using drugs or alcohol on the trip will be removed from the trip immediately.**

These **training events will not be paid** and will require you to show your commitment to learning about your culture by investing you time to make sure this trip is as safe and meaningful as possible.
