Community approved APP'S are

- (1) Substance Abuse
- (2) Domestic Violence
- (3) Youth - Substance Abuse

- (1) This month the detachment addressed the issue of Substance abuse by conducting dedicated community patrols. Wha Ti members continue to receive information on how alcohol and drugs are being brought into the community. Patrols are made for the purpose of intercepting alcohol and drugs on land, air and water. There have been multiple seizures of liquor and drugs so far this year. Liquor was intercepted on the winter road in March.
- (2) There were 3 reported domestic assaults in March 2014. The accused persons have been identified and are set to appear in Territorial Court over the coming months..
- (3) This month the detachment was involved with the youth by speaking with them at the school, youth center, skating rink, toboggan hill, on the playgrounds and around the community when patrolling. The youth of this community frequently attend the Wha Ti detachment for stickers and coloring books, this opportunity is used to educate the youth on the abuse of alcohol and drugs. New books focusing on youth and drugs have been distributed during March with discussions had with the youth on the content. Both members of the Detachment make regular visits to the school each month. Members attend to the Youth Center and interact with the youth here as well. Members took time on their days off to take the youth tobogganing on two separate weekends.

Notable Occurrences for the Month:

On March 19th 2014 Four Youth broke in to one of the teacher's residence while they were away. The youth gained entry with the use of crowbars and searched the entire residence for valuables. The youth were all intoxicated and drinking inside of the residence. Three arrests so far have made and all matters were sent to Wha Ti Court on 2014-06-03.

No concerns were raised during the month of March 2014.

- Members played with Youth at the local Youth Center X2
- Members attended the school and acted as judges for the Heritage Fair

- Members gave several youth tours of the Wha Ti RCMP detachment
- Members took youth tobogganing on their day off two weekends in a row
