Motion Required – Travel Policy

This travel policy will take place of the travel policy issued in the financial policy #2011-082 and amended policy in February Motion #2012-021. The reasoning for this policy is to set and define responsibility for the travel and related expenses that the Community Government of Whati will reimburse to the Employees and Elected Officials. It was early February, 2011 when council last reviewed the facility usage fees and rates. Currently, the only two (2) facilities that we rent, for a ½ or full day, are the council chambers and the culture centre, therefore this policy addresses only these two facilities.

While it is understandable that council will want to continue to subsidize these rates for non-commercial (residential) services, the reality is that **commercial rates** must be adjusted due to increase in operational and maintenance costs. As council is aware the Government funding and grants are shrinking day by day, it is the right time to generate some extra income to cover the costs.

Administration requests the Council to update and approve the increase of facility usage rates and fees by 20%. If Council accepts these adjustments, then these rates will come into effect on Friday June 1, 2018 and this rate schedule will be forwarded to the various government departments, businesses and other organizations with whom we do business.
