

Community Government of Behchokò BYLAW NUMBER 150-16

A bylaw of the municipal corporation of the Community Government of Behchokò in the Northwest Territories, pursuant to the provisions of the *Tłıcho Community Government Act*, S.N.W.T., for the purpose of cancelling a failed asset sale transaction.

WHEREAS the Tłįcho Community Government Act, S.N.W.T., 2004, provides authority for a community government to make bylaws Council considers appropriate;

AND WHEREAS the Bylaws listed in Article 2.1 are no longer deemed necessary or in the best interests of the residents of Behchokò;

AND WHEREAS the Bylaw 144-16, a bylaw to dispose of building asset on Lot 3, Block 1, Plan 1620, was drafted in anticipation of an asset sale;

AND WHEREAS it has been agreed that the asset sale transaction is now no longer mutually desirable to both the initial parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Community Government of Behchokò, in regular session, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1.0 CITATION OF BYLAW

1.1 This bylaw may be cited as the "Repeal of Bylaw 144-16"

2.0 APPLICATION OF BYLAW

2.1 Bylaw 144-16 shall be repealed and the transaction, as outlined in Bylaw 144-16, shall not be completed.

3.0 EFFECTIVE DATE

3.1 This Bylaw shall come into effect upon Third and Final Reading.

Read a First time this 6th day of December, 2016.

Read a Second time this 6th day of December, 2016.

Read a Third and Final time, and passed this 17th day of January, 2017.
