

Community Government of Behchokò

BYLAW NUMBER 163-18

A bylaw of the Community Government of Behchokò in the Northwest Territories to provide for the Declaration of Civic Holidays, pursuant to the provisions of the *Tłıchq Community Government Act, S.N.W.T. 2004, s69 – s72*.

WHEREAS the *Tłıchq Community Government Act, S.N.W.T., 2004, s69 – s72* provides authority for a community government to make bylaws Council considers appropriate;

AND WHEREAS the Community Government of Behchokò may desire, from time to time, to declare a civic holiday in the community for the purpose of hosting events, such as Behchokò Spring Carnival; and

AND WHEREAS it is sometimes not practical to call Council together for a Special Meeting simply to complete this declaration;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Community Government of Behchokò, in regular session, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1.0 CITATION OF BYLAW

1.1 This bylaw may be cited as the “*Declaration of a Civic Holiday Bylaw*”

2.0 DECLARATION

2.1 Council of the Community Government of Behchokò shall authorize the Chief to provide for the Declaration of a Civic Holiday and sign an appropriate Proclamation Form as attached as Appendix “A”, without a separate bylaw of Council, on the following conditions:

2.1.1 This authority shall only be exercised up to a maximum of two (2) times per calendar year, however one of the Civic Holiday Proclamations must be reserved for the annual Behchokò Carnival, and;

2.1.2 The Declaration of a Civic Holiday shall be for a maximum of one-half (½) day, and preferably from Noon to 5:00pm, and;

2.1.3 A copy of the signed Proclamation shall be forwarded electronically to

- Municipal & Corporate Affairs (to the attention of the Regional Superintendent),
- Tłıchq Government (to the attention of the Tłıchq Executive Officer), and
- TCSA offices (to the attention of the Chief Executive Officer),


a minimum of two (2) full working days in advance of the date of the Civic Holiday.


2.2 This Bylaw shall come into effect upon Third and Final Reading.

Read a First time this 6th day of March, 2018.


Read a Second time this 6th day of March, 2018.

Read a Third and Final time this 15th day of March, 2018.

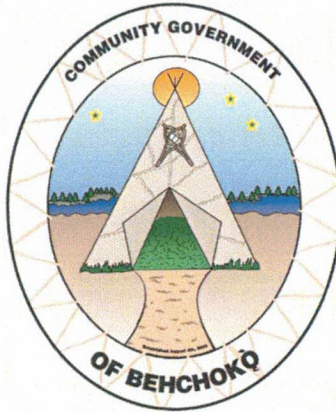
