TERMS OF REFERENCE

Tłącho Assembly Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee

A. APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEE

- 1. The Tłıcho Assembly will, by its own process, appoint a number of its members to act on the Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee, including appointment of alternate members.
- 2. Members appointed to the Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee will act at the pleasure of the Tłąchǫ Assembly.

B. PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEE

The Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee responsibilities include:

- Reviewing and providing advice on proposed legislation, guidelines, policies and procedures to implement the Land Use Plan and manage Tłįcho Lands, including but not limited to the development of the Minerals Strategy, Consultation and Engagement Guidelines, Land Use Guidelines and Woodcutting Guidelines;
- ii) As requested by the Tłıcho Assembly or Chiefs Executive Council (CEC), providing advice on Government of Canada and Government of the Northwest Territories legislation, policies, frameworks or other related materials;
- iii) As requested by the Tłįchǫ Assembly or CEC, providing advice on and participating in Environmental Assessment and Regulatory Proceedings;
- iv) Acting as a mechanism for feedback to and from Tłįchǫ communities on matters relating to the management of Tłįchǫ lands and resources; and
- v) Providing advice on other resource management and sustainability issues as directed by the Tł₁cho Assembly or CEC.

C. ADMINISTRATION

- 1. The Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee will be assisted by resource persons where required.
- 2. The Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee will meet as required.
- 3. The Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee will appoint one of its members as the chairperson who will have the primary responsibility for the direction of the Committee and communications with the Tłıcho Assembly and the CEC.

D. ACCOUNTABILITY

- 1. The Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee will be accountable to the Tłįchǫ Assembly.
- 2. The Resource Management and Sustainability Advisory Committee will report back to the Tłįchǫ Assembly on a regular basis and shall take instruction and direction relating to its responsibilities from the Tłįchǫ Assembly and/or the CEC.
