Thcho Assembly 20th Session Directive December 16, 2008

The Tłįcho Assembly held its 20th Session in Behchoko on December 9 - 16, 2008 and approved the following:

1. Extension of Assembly Session

The 20th Session of the Thcho Assembly is extended to Wednesday, December 17, 2008.

2. The Community Land Lease

The Thcho Government will contribute to the Behchoko Community Government funds up to \$98,000 from the Community Support Funds to do work with the other Thcho Communities to work towards resolving the issue of the GNWT \$2.00/year lease agreements for 99 years. (see item #8)

6. New Positions

The Thcho Executive Officer is authorized to hire an individual for a term of three months and this individual will assist in ensuring that the directives and decisions made by the Assembly are followed up and completed.



7. Caribou Collars

The Elders Advisory Council made the following recommendation to the Assembly:

As per the 19th Session Directive, the Elder's Advisory Council has met to discuss the request from Environment and Natural Resources to review the continuation of existing collars at 20 and to increase collared caribou from 20 to 30. The Elders Committee met with representatives of Environment and Natural Resources and Wek'èezhìı Renewable Resources Board to better understand why they have requested to continue the 20 existing collars and to increase the number of collared animals and to review the collaring process, including viewing the actual collars. Based on these meetings and our discussions, the Elders make the following recommendation:

The caribou collars should remain at the existing 20 and not be increased to 30 until such as time as the collars are redesigned.

The Thcho Assembly accepts the recommendation provided by the Elders Advisory Council. The Thcho Government shall provide a letter to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources to this effect.

12. Emergency Cabin

Wekweètì will develop cost for an emergency cabin and table it at the next Tłįcho Assembly Session.

13. Youth Coordinator

The Tłıcho Executive Officer to look into an interim Youth Coordinator to work with youth in the region on traditional and current activities. The Tłıcho Executive Officer will also work with the individual identified and table cost associated with this position for Assembly consideration at the next Session.

15. Whatì Motel/Restaurant/Store

The Tłıcho Government will raise this request at the upcoming meeting with the Tłıcho Investment Corporation and will report back to the next Tłıcho Assembly Session.

16. Review Assembly Members Fee

17. Elders Fuel Subsidy

The Tłįchǫ Government will assist elders, those with privately owned homes in the communities, with up to 500 litres of fuel or equivalent cost for wood. Elders that currently receive Canada Pension qualify for this assistance. The Tłįchǫ Government will raise the Elders fuel subsidy issue with Tłįchǫ Community Services Agency and GNWT at their upcoming meeting.

18. Bison Tags

Tłįchǫ Government to conduct research into whether unrestricted hunting is allowed for bison by Tłįchǫ citizens on Tłįchǫ lands. GNWT make available additional bison tags for community and commercial purposes. A report will be presented at the next Assembly Session.

19. Media Release

The Tłıcho Government will consider the development of a Tłıcho Government Newsletter at the next Tłıcho Assembly Session.

20. Scheduling

The 21st Tł₁cho Assembly Session will be held January 27 – 29, 2009 in Behchokò.
