Speaker Thcho Assembly

The Thcho Assembly is the law-making authority for the Thcho Government. The Assembly meets at least five (5) times per year in each of the four (4) Thcho communities on a rotational basis. One of these meetings shall be held at an Annual Gathering. The Assembly requires a Speaker to chair all sessions of the Thcho Assembly and shall serve at the pleasure of the Assembly.

Duties and responsibilities:

- The Speaker has the responsibility to chair all sessions of the Thcho Assembly.
- The Speaker enforces the Rules of Order.
- The Speaker ensures there is decorum during Thcho Sessions.
- The Speaker may be called upon to chair Thcho Assembly workshops and caucus and other related duties.

In exercising this duty, the Speaker:

- Must remain objective and neutral on issues facing the Thcho Assembly
- Must not summarize the discussions of the Assembly
- Must not be in conflict of interest
- Must understand the Thcho Rules of Order
- Must have knowledge of the T\u00e4cho Constitution
- Must have knowledge of Thcho culture, language and way of life

Criteria:

- Must be a Thcho Citizen
- Must speak the Thcho and English languages fluently
- Cannot be a member of the Tłįcho Assembly
- Must have experience in chairing meetings
- Preference may be given to those applicants with grade 12 diploma or equivalent

Salary/Fee:

Remuneration shall be the same rate as for the Assembly Members pursuant to Schedule A of the *Thcho Assembly and Chiefs Executive Council Schedule B Amendment Law 2009* or any subsequent amendments and includes time for preparation.
