

2nd Tł̥ch̥q̥ Assembly
14th Session Directive
February 22nd - 23rd, 2012

The 2nd Tł̥ch̥q̥ Assembly held its 14th Session in Whatì, on February 22nd - 23rd, 2012 and approved the following:

1. Dennison Road

Government of Canada wants to do mine reclamation work and wishes to enter into discussions with Tł̥ch̥q̥ Government concerning a possible road Right-of-Way Agreement over Tł̥ch̥q̥ Lands associated with the past named “Denison Winter Road”. The Tł̥ch̥q̥ Lands Protection Department is authorized to enter into discussions with the Government of Canada concerning this proposed Right of Way agreement and will make recommendations at an upcoming Assembly session.

2. Strategic Framework for the Tł̥ch̥q̥ Government

The Assembly approves in principle the draft document *It̥è d̥q̥ gha g̥ata...in Tł̥ch̥q̥ Unity...* the Strategic Framework and Intentions 2009-2013 of the Tł̥ch̥q̥ Government recognizing that there will be a series of technical changes and modifications required to the document prior to publication.

3. Devolution

The Tł̥ch̥q̥ Assembly approves the Engagement Strategy on Devolution and the Assembly instruct the Tł̥ch̥q̥ Executive Officer to coordinate the sending of a letter to the Government of the Northwest Territories to implement chapter 23.5.1 of the Tł̥ch̥q̥ Agreement and involve the Tł̥ch̥q̥ Government in the development and implementation of any Devolution Agreement to ensure the protection and respect of the provisions of the Tł̥ch̥q̥ Agreement.
