BENEFIT DISTRIBUTION BUDGET AMENDMENT LAW 2005

Title

1. This Law may be cited as the Benefit Distribution Budget Amendment Law 2005.

Definition

2. In this Law,

"Budget 2005-2006" means the budget for November 1, 2005 to March 31, 2006 approved in the *Budget Implementation Law 2005-2006* by the Thcho Assembly on October 27, 2005.

"Starter Budget" means the Thcho Starter Budget for April 1, 2005 to October 31, 2005 approved by the Thcho Assembly on August 4, 2005.

"Thcho Citizen" means a person whose name is on the Register on the date that this Law is signed.

Payment to each Thcho citizen

3. The Thcho Government is authorized to make a one time payment to each Thcho Citizen of \$150.00.

Amendment of the budget

4. The Budget 2005-2006 is amended to allocate that portion of the PBA Diavik and IBA BHP reserve funds identified in the Starter Budget that are required to enable the Thcho Government to make the payments identified in section 3.

Coming into force

5. This Law shall come into force on the date when the Grand Chief signs this Law.
