The Tłchq value respect for all living things and respect for each other.

The members of the Chiefs Executive Council shall treat each other with respect and shall work together for the collective betterment for all Tłchq.


The members of the Chiefs Executive Council shall not abuse, harass, demean, threaten or disrespect each other, members of the Tłchq Assembly, employees of Tłchq Government, resource persons and Tłchq Citizens.

Accountability

1. The Chiefs Executive Council shall take direction from the Tłchq Assembly.
2. The Chiefs Executive Council shall provide a written report to the Tłchq Assembly at each session.
3. The Chiefs Executive Council shall provide quarterly financial statements to the Tłchq Assembly.
4. The Chiefs Executive Council shall exercise powers as delegated through the arranging for the implementation of Tłchq laws as approved by the Tłchq Assembly.

Chiefs Executive Council Meetings

1. The Chiefs Executive Council shall hold all scheduled meetings on Tłıchǫ Lands, in a Tłıchǫ community or in Yellowknife and shall have open meetings except to deal with in-camera issues.
2. The Chiefs Executive Council meetings shall be held as needed.
3. The Chiefs Executive Council meetings shall be scheduled in advance.
