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**TŁICHQ GOVERNMENT IBA/PA IMPLEMENTATION BUDGET  
LAW 2006 - 2007**

**Title**

1. This law may be cited as the *Tłichq Government IBA/PA Implementation Budget Law 2006 - 2007*.

**Definition**

2. In this law,  
  
“Proposed Budget” means the budget for April 1, 2006 to March 31, 2007 prepared by Chief’s Executive Council pursuant to *Tłichq Finance Law* and recommended by the Chief’s Executive Council attached to this Law as Schedule A.

**Adoption and Approval of the Budget**

3. The Proposed Budget is adopted and approved as the budget of the Tłichq Government for the IBA/PA funds for the period April 1, 2006 to March 31, 2007.

**Coming into force**

4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into force on April 1, 2006.

IBA/PA Budget 2006-2007**

**Budget Explanation**

**1. Tłchq Scholarship \$ 500,000**

The purpose of the Tłchq Scholarship Fund Project is to promote the post-secondary education of Tłchq citizens through the administration of a series of scholarships that encourage academic achievement in high school students, and support students while studying at university, college, technical school or other post secondary institutions. In 1997-98 the Treaty 11 Council approved \$250,000 for scholarships and since 1999 approval for \$500,000 has been given each year. Hundreds of Tłchq citizens have been helped with their post secondary education since 1999 giving the Tłchq Nation the highest number of students on a per capita basis in the NWT attending post secondary education. The funding is used primarily as grants to students with some funds going to a program coordinator.

**2. DeBeers Cultural Program Development \$ 1,000,000**

The Tłchq Government shall establish and operate a program to facilitate participation by Tłchq Citizens who want to continue their traditional economic activities based on the land and its resources.

**3. IBA Coordinator \$ 150,000**

There are Impact Benefit Agreements (IBAs) with BHP Billiton, Diavik Diamond Mine and DeBeers and as a result, there are certain obligations by the parties that must be carried out. The Tłchq government will create the position of IBA Coordinator and the Coordinator will ensure the Tłchq Government implement its' obligation and commitments.

**4. Annual Canoe Trip \$ 250,000**

The Tłchq Government will have its annual gathering in Wekweètì on August 2-4, 2006. The canoes will travel from Behchokò, Whatì and Gamètì to Wekweètì and the trip may take about 2 weeks. It is estimated 150 persons may participate on this trip.

**5. Annual Gathering \$ 200,000**

The Tłchq Government will have its annual gathering in Wekweètì on August 2-4, 2006. There is currently \$300,000 in the Tłchq Government Budget for this fiscal year. Due to the higher cost of having an annual gathering in Wekweètì, there is a need for additional funds. Included in this cost will be the development of an annual report.

**6. Rae Graveyard \$ 100,000**

The graveyard in Rae is in need of repair. The work to be done will include clean up of the area, repair some graves and the level the area with dirt/gravel.

**7. New Tłchq Government Building \$ 500,000**

The Tłchq Government will need to work on building its own building for its governmental business. This initiative will take time and proper planning and in the meantime, a saving account or reserved funding should be set up in order to establish cash capital or equity. This will reduce the overall cost of the building and lessen the need for financing.

**8. Donation/Funeral Support \$ 290,000**

The Tłchq Government is currently funding most of the funeral expenses and other donations. The current donation budget for this fiscal year may not be sufficient to cover all donation requests and funeral support cost. Additional funding is required.

**9. Tłchq Heritage Resources Project \$ 45,000**

The purpose of the Tłchq Heritage Resources project is to ensure the security, organization and accessibility of all sound, video recordings of Tłchq elders present and past. The existing collections in the Tłchq Government/Tłchq Community Services Agency (TG/TCSA) and in private hands in the communities must be duplicated as soon as possible and one collection put away for safekeeping. The other collection must be digitized, indexed, catalogued and loaded to TG/TCSA servers and made accessible to the public through the Tłchq web project. These heritage resources form a foundation for the cosmology project, and are very useful for other TG/TCSA projects and work including lands management, language and cultural programs at the schools, and others. The funding is used primarily for employment for summer students for July and August, casual workers in August through December and a coordinator. Some equipment will be needed.

**10. Investment Corporation – Capital Projects \$ 1,300,000**

The Investment Corporation requires funding for various capital projects and investments totalling \$1,6 million. The total amount allocated is \$1.3 million. The Investment Corporation will cover the outstanding required amount of \$300,000. The capital projects include the following:

**a. Nurse Station – Upgrade – Behchokq  
\$ 325,000**

The upgrade will include 2 ambulance bays and 5 office spaces. A mortgage of \$325,000 is needed to secure a loan of \$1.8 million. It will be

built by the Rae-Edzo Dene Band Development Corporation and leased to the Tł̨ch̨q̨ Community Services Agency.

- b.     Wekweètì – Tł̨ch̨q̨ Government Building**  
**\$360,000**

The building will included offices for Tł̨ch̨q̨ Government, Wek'èezhì Land and Water Board, Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board, community store and other tenants. \$60,000 will be needed for the building design and \$300,000 for a down payment on a \$1.1 million bank financing.
- c.     Wekweètì Development Corporation – Support**  
**\$55,000**

The Tł̨ch̨q̨ Government is required to provide financial support to its various corporations from time to time. A total of \$55,000 is required to provide financial support to the store (\$25,000), motel for cashflow (\$15,000) and Wekweètì Development Corporation for cashflow (\$15,000).
- d.     Gamètì Store – purchase**  
**\$580,000**

The Tł̨ch̨q̨ Government will purchase the store in Gamètì. Approximately \$580,000 will be required to purchase the store. The estimated cost of the store is \$250,000, plus \$300,000 for the stock and \$30,000 in management support.
- e.     Gamètì Development Corporation – Motor**  
**\$30,000**

The Gamètì Development Corporation owns a grader that requires a new motor. Once the grader is repaired, the Development Corporation could lease or rent out the grader.
- f.     Whatì – Tlı̨cho Government Building**  
**\$140,000**

The Tł̨ch̨q̨ Government is looking at building a building in Whatì. A needs assessment is required to determine whether a new building should be constructed.
- g.     Whatì Community Store – Support**  
**\$40,000**

The Tł̨ch̨q̨ Government is required to provide financial support to its various corporations from time to time. The Whatì Community Store requires \$40,000 to assist with its operational cashflow.
- h.     Whatì Development Corporation – Support**

**\$45,000**

The T̄chq̄ Government is required to provide financial support to its various corporations from time to time. The What̄ Development Corporation requires financial assistance of \$45,000 to assist with operational cashflow. This will include assistance with the housing projects, payment of a bobcat and grader engine repair.

**i. Rabesca Resources Ltd. – research**

**\$25,000**

The T̄chq̄ Government will do research into the potential purchase of Rabesca Resources Ltd.

**11. Wekweèti Graveyard**

**\$ 16,589**

The graveyard in Wekweèti is located several kilometers from the community on an island. The community will construct a shelter at the graveyard.
